

The FCS Report for BCC meeting March 2017

1. Felling of trees on FCS ground at Balmaha has started and should be completed by 6th March 2017, so this should be now completed. Harvesting is still ongoing in the Rowardennan felling coupe, this will continue into the summer 2017.
2. We will hopefully be in a position to install the new site signage for Balmaha trail in the car park, a production issue has resulted in a delay with the signage legs, this should be resolved very soon.
3. Sallochys campsite is now open again, starting a month earlier for 2017 season. The wardens are appointed with some familiar faces from last year (Helen (supervisor), Moira and David). We are working closely with the National Park authority "Respect Your Park" camping project, much is the same as last year with a small adjustment in the charges, £7/person and £1 concession per night.
