

Forestry Report June 2018

The Hoish – following a review of the temporary closure of the layby outside the entrance to our timber stacking yard we have taken the decision to close this on a permanent basis for safety reasons. Although the number of incidents reduced we continued to experience incidents of people walking through the yard in close proximity to working forestry machines and stacked timber. The yard is a high risk area and so in the interests of the safety of all visitors to The Hoish and of our operators we have taken the decision to close this layby.

There is parking available at Old Drymen Road (<http://scotland.forestry.gov.uk/forest-parks/queen-elizabeth-forest-park/old-drymen-road>) and our High Corrie waymarked trail heads into the forest for good views over the Carse of Stirling and the Highland Boundary Fault.
